Version 2.0.2 Release Notes

General Description

This version update contains recent feature enhancements and fixes.

Operating Systems

This version has been tested with Windows 10 32-bit and 64-bit versions.

Modifications and Known Issues

1. The licensing system has been modified. At minimum, this requires a new USB license key.
2. To reduce visual clutter, users see what is licensed.
3. For Essentials, everything is visible so the user can see all of the software's potential without paying for it.
4. The UI has been updated significantly to eliminate context menus and place controls at the topmost layer. Almost everything is 1-2 clicks away.
5. Build targets have been reduced from 8 to 2: ProAnalyst Essentials (free) and 2023 (non-free).
6. ProAnalyst licensing options have expanded from internet subscription to a true subscription model.
7. Feature tracking changes
 - a. Delete mode has been replaced with 4 clear track point buttons: Clear current, forward, backward, and all.
 - b. The modes are now automatic, step manual (increments features and frames), and full manual which does not auto-increment.
 - c. Virtual points are now denoted using a checkbox which toggles on/off depending on the state.
 - d. The interpolation controls have their own location and are no longer buried in the context menu.
 - e. Feature attributes (search region, labels, templates, etc.) may be changed using a single combobox control.
 - f. The settings button in the display options region controls the fade and vector scales which are appropriate when show track points is set to all or past.
 - g. Buttons have been redesigned for non-English speaking users or people with color blindness.
 - h. The UI has been updated for a cleaner and more modern look and feel.
8. Constrained Edge tracking (formerly known as 1D line tracking) changes
 - a. The UI has similar updates as Feature tracking.
 - b. Line and Line scan view are now clickable icons instead of checkboxes.
9. Image Processing (formerly Image filtering) has a toggle button to enable/disable all filters in the list.
10. Look-up Table (formerly Image Processing) has minor updates.
11. The Notes and Layers have been mostly merged.
12. Annotations and Notes are now licensable as Reports and Presentation.
13. The semantics have been streamlined to avoid conflicts such as lines connecting track points are now called stick models instead of lines. Similarly, points are now called track points.
